SQUADRON SPONSORING COMMITTEE SUPPORT PROGRAM 2014-15

The Squadron Sponsoring Committee Support Program (SSCSP) promotes three facets of the Air Cadet organization at the Squadron level, specifically Leadership, Community Service and Academic Success. The SSCSP provides cash awards to Squadron Sponsoring Committees based on their SSCSP score and to the cadets it sponsors; cadets who lead at their squadron, perform community service and excel in academic endeavors.

SQUADRON SPONSORING COMMITTEE PRIZES

All Squadron Sponsoring Committees in good standing are eligible for one of seven cash awards. Nominations are to be made by the League Liaison.

GOOD STANDING AWARDS

First place - \$1,000 Second place - \$500 Third place - \$500 Fourth – Seventh place - \$250

A Squadron must satisfy the mandatory requirements of this program on time to be considered in Good Standing.

SQUADRON LEADERSHIP AND COMMUNITY SERVICE BURSARIES

All cadets who belong to a squadron with a squadron sponsoring committee in good standing may be nominated for these bursaries by their local sponsoring committee.
